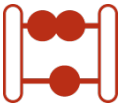
... we cross-link

Mobility Support

ICM – Centre for International Cooperation & Mobility

Ernst Mach Grant worldwide one to nine months for studies in Austria for PhD students, postgraduates, postdocs, university lecturers

Ernst Mach Grant for Universities of Applied Sciences (*Fachhochschulen*)

Franz Werfel Grant up to 18 months for university lecturers from all over the world focusing on Austrian literature, follow-up support

Richard Plaschka Grant up to 18 months for PhD Students and university lecturers of history focusing on Austrian history, follow-up support
